Invitation to Artists

Eligibility

- 18 years of age or older
- Resident of SW Washington

Media Accepted

- Original art designed and produced by the artist
- Three entries per artist
- Two dimensional (2D) oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, drawing, prints, mixed media, collage, photography, fiber, art quilts, etc.
- Three dimensional (3D) sculpture, pottery, glass, jewelry, egg art, textiles, woodwork, garden art, gourds, basketry, etc.
- 2D securely wired for hanging (no sawtooth hangers or clips)

Media Not Accepted

- Artwork entered in a prior BGAA show
- Kits, commercially made items, reproductions
- 2D exceeding 45" in any direction including frame for first piece; 40" for subsequent pieces
- 3D exceeding 40 lbs

Theme: One entry of the 3 allowed may be submitted for the theme category of "Tree of Life."

Awards

- First, second and third place awards each in 2D and 3D categories
- * Best of Show
- People's Choice
- Best Interpretation of Theme

Sales

- Include sales tax in asking price. Artist responsible for compliance with state tax requirements.
- BGAA accepts 25% commission on all sales.
- Checks mailed to artists within 10 days.

How to Enter:

- Fill out all parts of entry form for each piece entered, completely and legibly.
- Bring work to the Community Center Friday, March 23 between 9AM and 1PM to be juried.
- Artists whose work is not accepted will be contacted by 7PM, and that work must be picked up by 12PM Saturday, March 24.
- Submit fee of \$30 for first piece and \$5 for each additional piece; BGAA members \$20 for first piece and \$5 for each additional piece.

Show Hours

- Saturday, March 24 show open 10AM to 8PM; Artists' Reception 5 to 8PM; Awards Presentation 6:30 to 7PM
- Sunday, March 25 show open 11 AM to 3PM; Artists pick up work between 3:15 and 4PM

Responsibilities

- Work left after 4PM Sunday will be charged a storage fee of \$10 per day. Artist must contact BGAA to arrange later pickup.
- Every precaution will be taken to protect entries; however, BGAA and the Battle Ground Community Center assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage.
- Entry in the show gives BGAA permission to use any photographic images taken of that work for the sole purpose of promoting BGAA.
